Who conducts the programme?

A

A Classroom Co-Facilitator, who is a trained teacher, partners with the class teacher to modify and design learning activities to help the children learn at their own pace during their regular lessons.

Q

Can the Classroom Co-Facilitator work with children requiring greater support?

A

No, children who require greater support may have specific needs that can only be met by specialised professionals such as a Therapist.

Q

How can I find out about the progress of my child?

A

Besides the initial Welcome Letter, progress updates will be sent during the programme. Parents are encouraged to speak to the class teacher and Classroom Co-Facilitator to find out more.
