Bright Horizons Fund (BHF) provides financial, social, health & well-being, as well as learning & development programmes support for preschool children from low-income families. Between January and June 2024, 5,233 children have benefitted from our programmes.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT PROGRAMMES



NTUC FIRST CAMPUS SPONSORED NTUC MEMBERSHIP PROGRAMME

2,460 Families

This programme enables low-income families to access the various financial and employability benefits for NTUC members. This privilege will continue till their child or youngest child leaves NTUC First Campus's preschool network.



BRIGHT HORIZONS FUND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SCHEMES

938 Children

This support includes financial assistance for Childcare Fees, School Uniforms and Field Trip Expenses.

OCBC-NTUC FIRST CAMPUS
BRIDGING PROGRAMME

108 Children

This programmes offers children from low-income families who are newly enrolled in My First Skool centres to receive a one-time \$400 top-up into their Child Development Account.

HEALTH AND WELL-BEING PROGRAMMES



YOU'VE GOT TALENT PROGRAMME

347 Children

Through the You've Got Talent programme, children are provided with opportunities to build their confidence and boost their self-esteem by participating in various sports and arts enrichment programmes.



FAMILY AND SCHOOL TOGETHER

1,092 Participants

The Family and School Together (FAST) programme offers educational tours and excursions for families to promote bonding time between parents and children through fun activities. This year, participants were able to enjoy a day brimming with science adventures and exciting activities at the Singapore Science Centre.

INFANT NUTRITION PROGRAMME

74 Children

The Infant Nutrition Programme supports My First Skool Children (up to 36 months old) from low-income families to afford a range of infant nutritional products necessary for their growth.



HEALTHY BODY, HEALTHY MIND WORKSHOP

86 Families

The workshop provides tips and strategies for parents to develop good eating habits in children and help caregivers to take care of their own well-being.

CAREGIVER CONVERSATIONS

119 Families

The workshop aims to build resilience in parents to better support their children's development and to equip them with skills to manage anger, defiance and aggression in children.

LEARNING PROGRAMMES







CLASSROOM SUPPORT PROGRAMME

583 Children

The Learning Facilitators conduct small-group activities to support children from low-income families to enhance their academic and social-emotional performance in the classroom. 212 children out of the 583 children which benefitted from the programme were under the 7 MFS centres that is funded by CapitaLand Hope Foundation.



BRIGHT HORIZONS FUND BOOK HAMPER PROGRAMME


2,139 Families
